Frank Costa retires from Costa board



Frank Costa will step back from his board role at Costa Group, the business his family founded

Frank Costa, who has been the proprietor of Costa Group since 1959, has announced his retirement as a non-executive director on the board of the company, effective from 4 July.

In recent years after stepping back from an executive role, Costa contributed during the private equity phase and in his role as non-executive director since 2015 when Costa became a public company.

Costa will continue to retain his involvement with the company as an advisor on the board.
