Total Produce has released an update confirming that that trading for the ten months ended 31 October remained positive, despite the backdrop of Covid-19.

According to the group, sales have continued to be resilient in its Wholesale and Retail sectors, offsetting reduced demand from Foodservice.

Sales, adjusted EBITDA and adjusted earnings per share are now expected

to be slightly ahead of full year 2019, it noted.
