Capespan unveils robust results

Group turnover remains more or less the same as last year, while operating profit comes in at €10.5m

Leading South African export company Capespan has reported strong performances in all its divisions during 2007, with revenues topping the R2bn (€161m) mark

for the first time, according to managing director Neil Oosthuizen.

“Operating profit increased 157 per cent to R98.7m (€7.96m) while the total

volume of fruit sold rose by 4 per cent to 59m cartons,” he said.
