Amendments improve export access to India



Australian apple and pear producers allowed to use in-transit cold treatment when exporting to India

Exporters of Australian grown apple and pears have gained improved access to the Indian market following amendments to India's Plant Quarantine Order legislation.

The amendments, which allow

Australian exporters to use in-transit cold treatment (ITCT) for products shipped to India, are effective immediately.

The improved export arrangements provide Australian apple

and pear exporters the same level of market access to India as they currently have when shipping to Argentina, Brazil and Serbia.
